





#### How to Sew the Rob Peter to Pay Paul Quilt Block:


Step 1



Remove cut pieces from dies and lay out as shown.




Pin one piece B to piece A right sides together matching center notches. The point end of piece B will extend about <sup>1</sup>/4" beyond the squared off end of piece A. Stitch with a <sup>1</sup>/4" seam allowance, with piece A on top, easing the two curved edges to match. Carefully finger press seam allowance toward B pieces after each seam is stitched. Place iron on seams to set finger pressed seams. Avoid pushing fabric with iron which can cause block distortion. Step 3




Following Step 2 instructions, pin and sew second piece B to center piece A.

Step 4



Continue to pin and sew third piece B to center piece A.

#### Step 5



Once block is complete, trim off dog ears from block corners. Block should measure  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ ".
