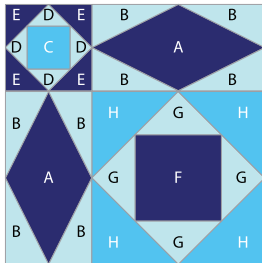




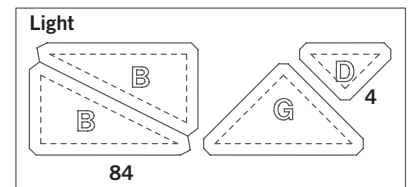
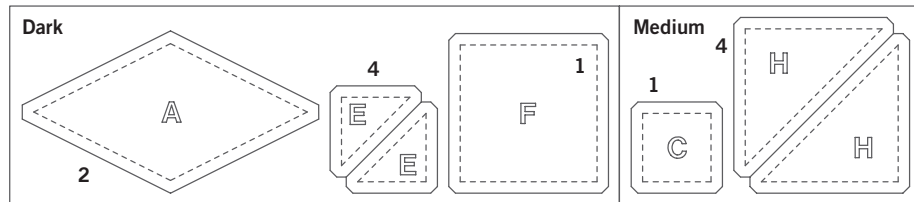
# GO!® Storm at Sea-9" Finished

## Fabric Cutting Tips for a 3-color, 9" finished Storm at Sea Block with Single Sashing:



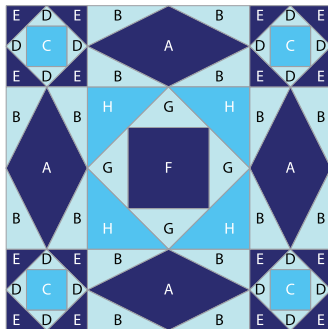
Shapes needed for 9" finished Storm at Sea (single sashing)



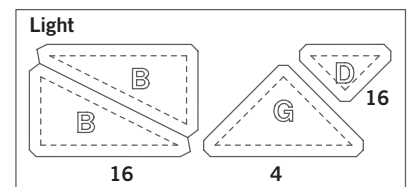
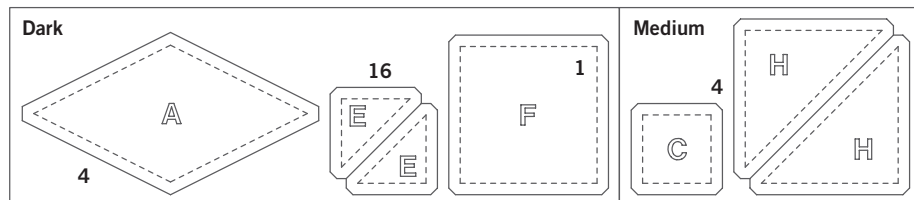
Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

- Fabric Color 1 (dark): Cut two  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" rectangles and place over shapes A and E. Cut one 4" square and place over shape F.
- Fabric Color 2 (light): Cut four  $8\frac{3}{8}$ " x 3" rectangles (two facing up and two facing down or fanfold) and place over shapes B, D and G.
- Fabric Color 3 (medium): Cut one  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square and place over shape C. Cut two  $4\frac{3}{8}$ " squares and place over shapes H.

## Fabric Cutting Tips for a 3-color, 12" finished Storm at Sea Block with Double Sashing:



Shapes needed for 12" finished Storm at Sea (double sashing)



First pass through the cutter:

- Fabric 1 (dark): Cut four  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" rectangles and place over shapes A and E. Cut one 4" square and place over shape F.
- Fabric 2 (light): Cut four  $8\frac{3}{8}$ " x 3" rectangles (two facing up and two facing down or fanfold) and place over shapes B, D and G.
- Fabric 3 (medium): Cut four  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and place over shape C. Cut two  $4\frac{3}{8}$ " squares and place over shapes H.

Second pass through the cutter:

- Fabric 1 (dark): Cut four  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and place over shape E.
- Fabric 2 (light): Cut four  $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 3" rectangles and place over shape B. Cut six  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles and place over shape D.

Third pass through the cutter:

- Fabric 2 (light): Cut six  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles and place over shape D.

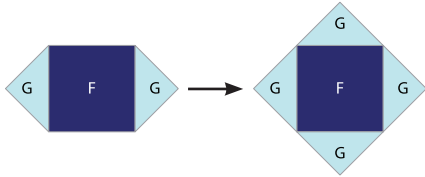

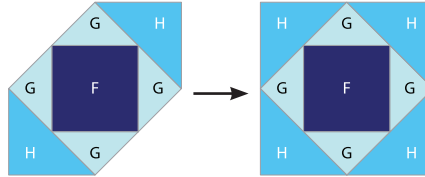
## How to Sew the 3-color, 9" finished Storm at Sea Block with Single Sashing:

### Step 1



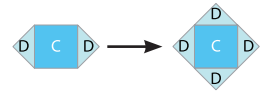
Sew piece G to each side of piece F on opposite sides as shown.

### Step 2



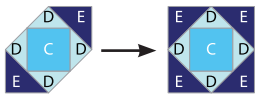
Sew piece H to each side of F/G on opposite sides as shown. Make one F/G/H unit.

### Step 3



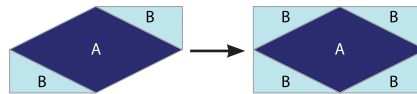
Sew piece D to each side of piece C on opposite sides as shown.

### Step 4



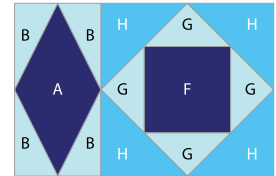
Sew piece E to each side of C/D on opposite sides as shown.

### Step 5



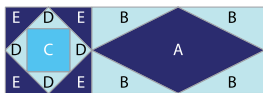
Sew piece B to each side of piece A on opposite sides as shown. Make two A/B units.

### Step 6



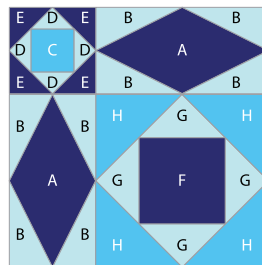
Sew vertical A/B unit on left side of F/G/H center unit.

### Step 7



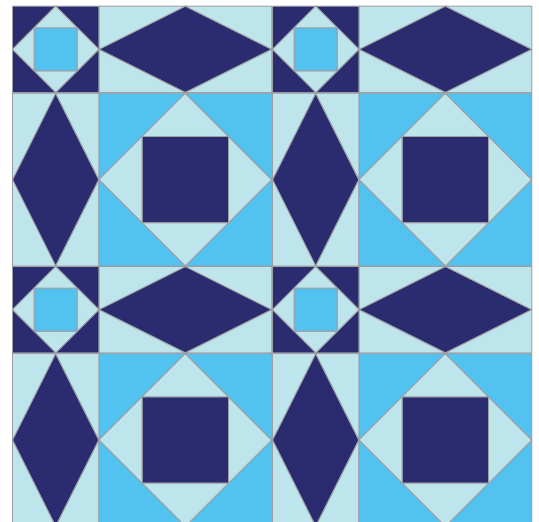
Sew C/D/E unit on left side of a horizontal A/B unit.

### Step 8



Sew the horizontal C/D/E/A/B unit to the top of the A/B/F/G/H unit to complete the repeating block.

### Step 9



Sew blocks together to create Storm at Sea blocks with single sashing.



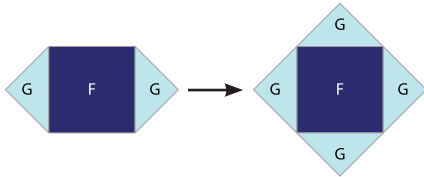

## How to Sew the 3-color, 12" finished Storm at Sea Block with Double Sashing:

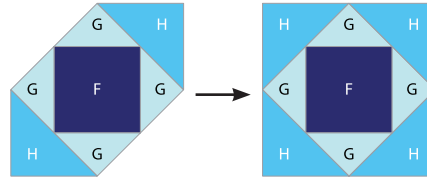
*Note: You also can make Storm at Sea blocks with double sashing with the GO! Storm at Sea-9" Finished die. To make blocks that finish at 12", you will need to cut an additional (2) A pieces, (8) B pieces, (3) C pieces, (12) D pieces & (12) E pieces.*

### Step 1



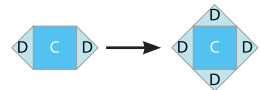
Sew piece G to each side of piece F on opposite sides as shown.

### Step 2



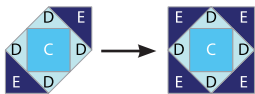
Sew piece H to each side of F/G on opposite sides as shown. Make one F/G/H unit.

### Step 3



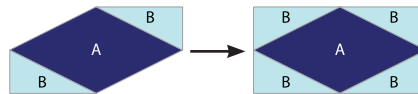
Sew piece D to each side of piece C on opposite sides as shown.

### Step 4



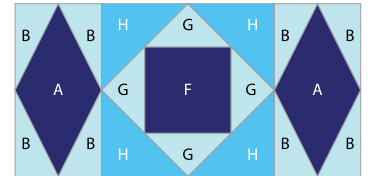
Sew piece E to each side of C/D on opposite sides as shown. Make four C/D/E units.

### Step 5



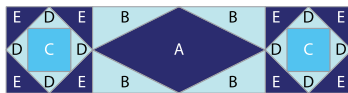
Sew piece B to each side of piece A on opposite sides as shown. Make four A/B units.

### Step 6



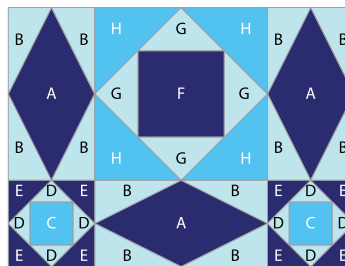
Sew vertical A/B units on each side of the F/G/H center unit to make the center row.

### Step 7



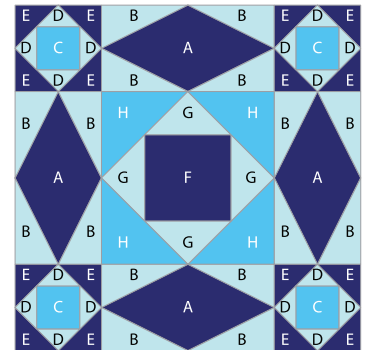
Sew a C/D/E unit on each side of a horizontal A/B unit. Make two rows.

### Step 8



Sew one of the horizontal A/B rows to the bottom of the F/G/H center row.

### Step 9



Sew the other horizontal A/B row to the top of the F/G/H center row.
