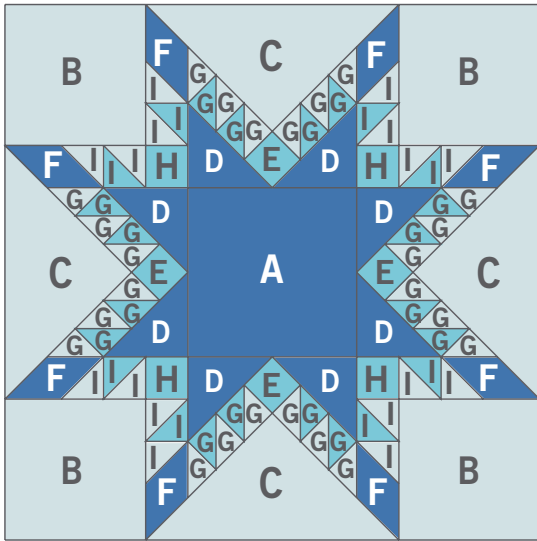

Fabric Cutting Tips for a 3-color, 16" finished Feather Star block:



Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

• **Fabric Color 1:**

- Cut one $6\frac{5}{8}$ " x 6" rectangle. Place right side up over shape A to cut.
- Cut four $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Place right side up over shapes D to cut.
- Cut four $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, fanfolded in half. Place right side up over shapes F to cut.

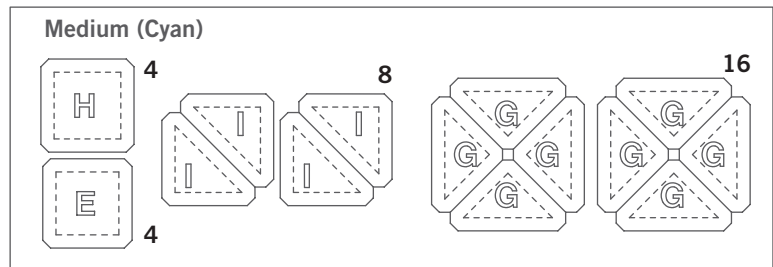
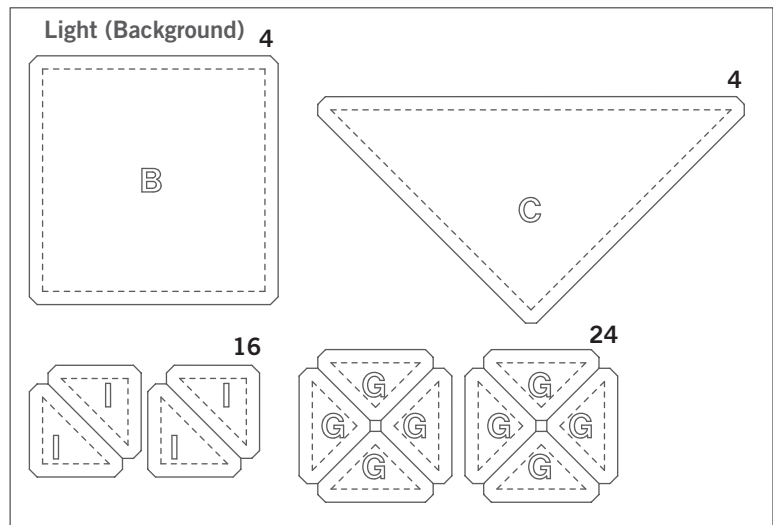
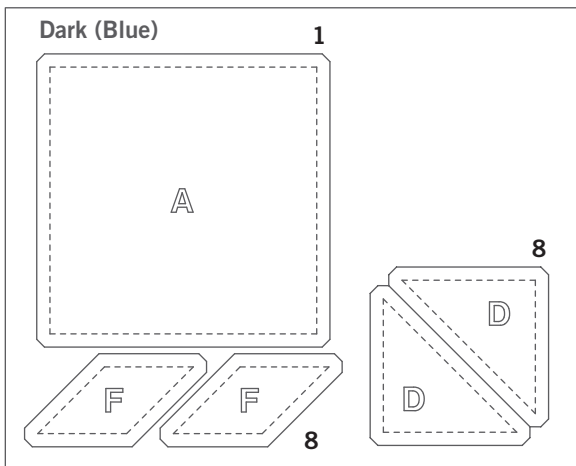
• **Fabric Color 2:**

- Cut four $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Place right side up over shape B to cut.
- Cut four $8\frac{5}{8}$ " x $4\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shape C to cut.
- Cut three $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes G to cut.
- Cut four $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{5}{8}$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes I to cut.

• **Fabric Color 3:**

- Cut four $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" rectangles. Place right side up over shapes H and E to cut.
- Cut two $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes G to cut.
- Cut two $4\frac{7}{8}$ " x $2\frac{5}{8}$ " rectangles. Place right side up over shapes I to cut.

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How to Sew the 3-color, 16" finished Feather Star Block:

Use a 1/4" seam allowance. Press as directed. *For easy Y seams, be sure to mark your 1/4" point on the wrong side of all pieces where they intersect. You will want to sew shape C by starting at the outside, sewing to the 1/4" mark and stopping. Then flip the piece to sew from the outside to the center again. Do not overlap your stitches. Backstitching when stopping will help secure the seam.

Step 1



Note: Fanfold fabric to cut F shapes for a total of four F shape sets. Select two I colors and sew together as shown.

Make 4 units.

Next sew F shapes to I shapes as shown to make F/I units. Make 2 units facing left and 2 units facing right.

Sew F/I units to I/I units. Make 2 F/I/I units facing left and 2 units facing right.

Step 2



Sew B shape to F/I/I/I units as shown. Make 2 B/F/I/I/I units facing left and 2 units facing right.

Step 3



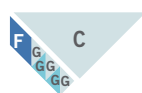
Select two G colors and sew together as shown. Make 16 units.

Next sew 2 G/G units together as shown. Make 4 G/G/G/G units.

Next sew a left F shape to a G shape as shown. Make 2 F/G units.

Then sew F/G to G/G/G/G as shown. Make 2 units.

Step 4



Sew C to F/G/G/G/G unit as shown. Make 2 units.

Step 5

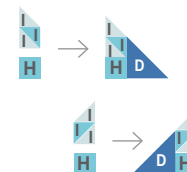


Sew a G shape and E shape to either side of a G/G/G/G unit (from step 3) as shown.

Next sew right facing F shape to unit G/G/G/G/G/E. Make 2 units.

Then sew F/G/G/G/G/E to the right side of the unit created in step 4. Make 2 units.

Step 6

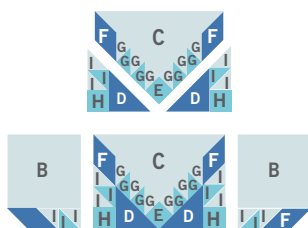


Sew together 3 I shapes as shown.

Next sew H shape to I/I/I unit as shown. Then sew shape D to H/I/I/I unit. Make 2 units.

Follow the same steps to make 2 additional mirror image units.

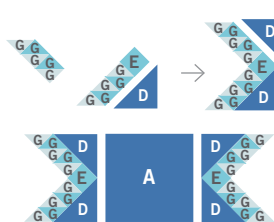
Step 7



Sew mirror image H/I/I/I/D units to either side of the unit created in step 5. Make 2 complete units.

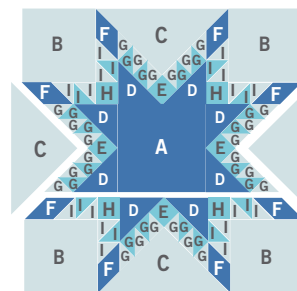
Next sew mirror image B/F/I/I/I units to either side of the unit as shown. Make 2 units.

Step 8



Sew a G/G/G/G unit and a G/G/G/G/E unit as shown. Next sew a D shape onto the G/G/G/G/G/E unit. Then sew the units together. Add another shape D as shown. Sew 2 complete units onto either side of shape A as shown.

Step 9



Note: Stop sewing 1/4" from the edge to allow for the Y seam in the next step.

Sew rows together then add 2 shape C's to the sides as shown.

Block should measure 16 1/2" square.

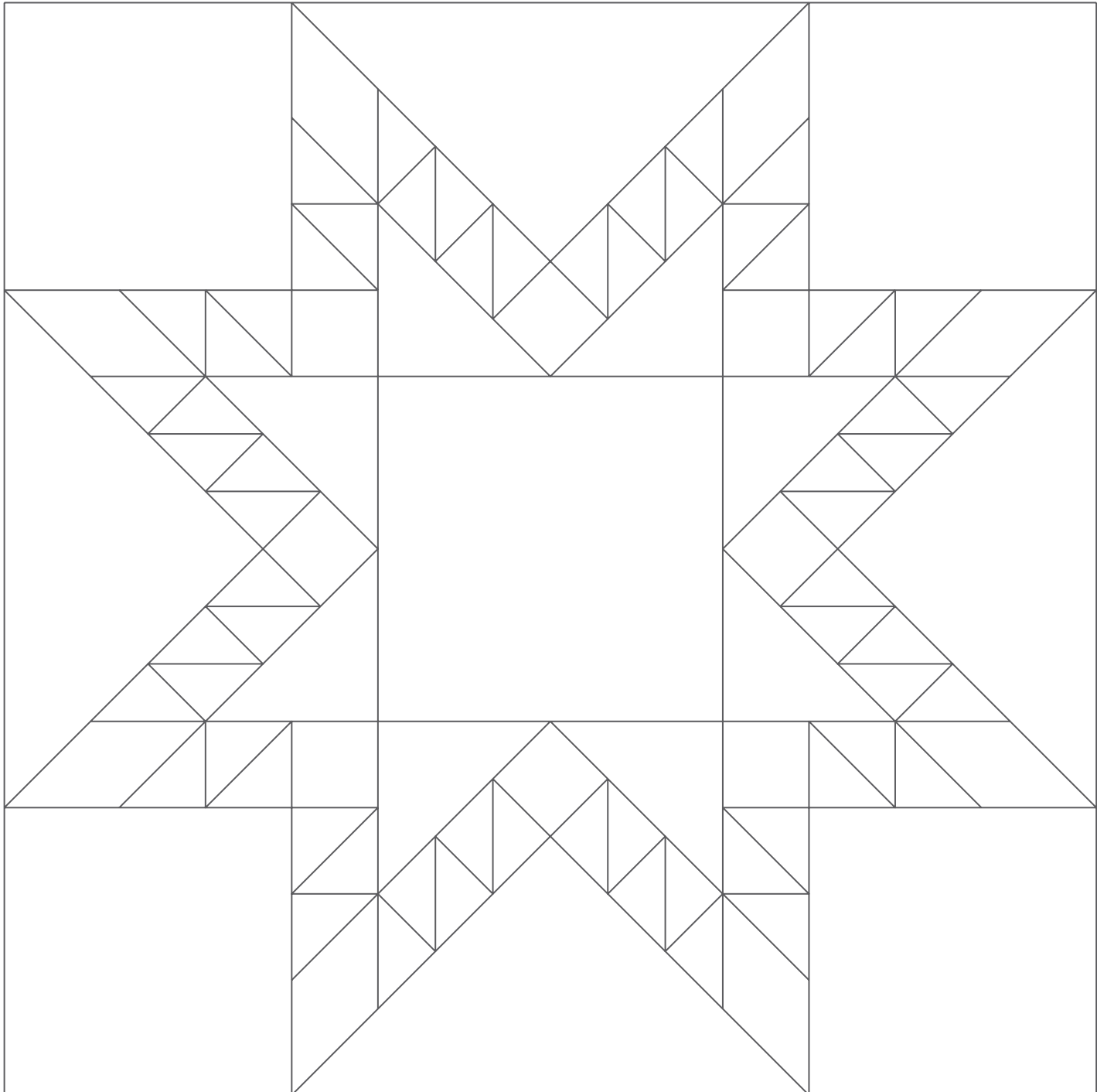


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Feather Star Quilt Block Coloring Page
