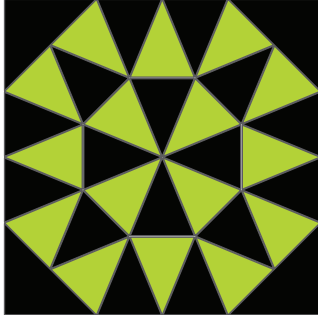




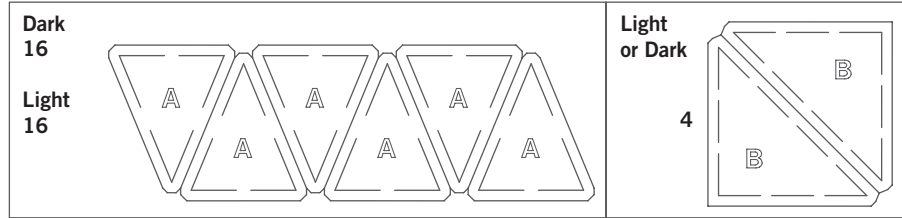

## Fabric Cutting Tips for a 2-color, 12" finished Morning Star Block:



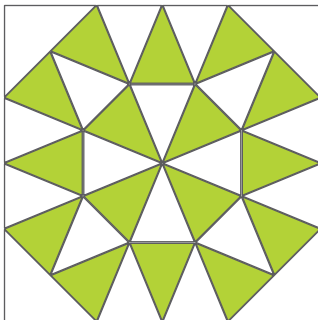
Shapes needed for 2-Color 12" finished Morning Star Block



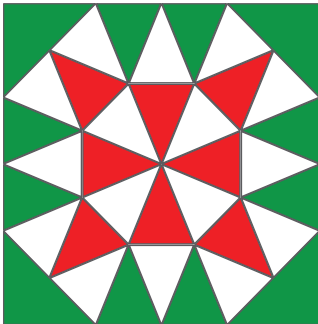
Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

- Fabric Color 1 (dark or light): Cut three 12" x 4½" rectangles and place over A shapes. Cut two 4⅞" x 4⅞" square and place over B shapes.
- Fabric Color 2 (light or dark): Cut three 12" x 4½" rectangles and place over A shapes.

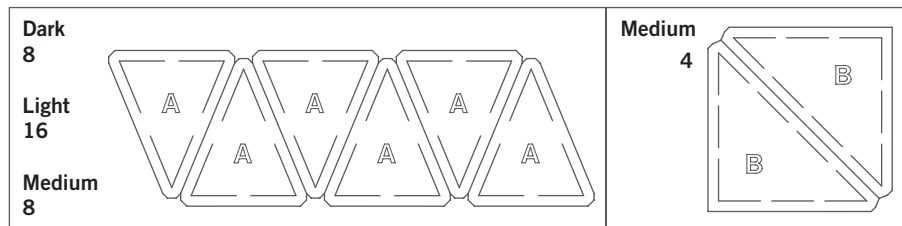
*Note: You will have two extra isosceles triangle shapes for each color. Set aside for future blocks.*



## Fabric Cutting Tips for a 3-color, 12" finished Morning Star Block:



Shapes needed for 3-Color 12" finished Morning Star Block



Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

- Fabric Color 1 (dark/red): Cut one 12" x 4½" rectangle and place over A shapes. Cut one 5¼" x 4¼" rectangle and place over two A shapes on the left side of the board.
- Fabric Color 2 (light/white): Cut three 12" x 4½" rectangles and place over A shapes.
- Fabric Color 3 (medium/green): Cut one 12" x 4½" rectangle and place over A shapes. Cut one 5¼" x 4¼" rectangle and place over two A shapes on the right side of the board. Cut two 4⅞" x 4⅞" square and place over B shapes.

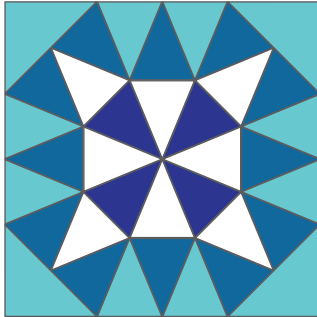
*Note: You will have two extra isosceles triangle shapes for color #2. Set aside for future blocks.*



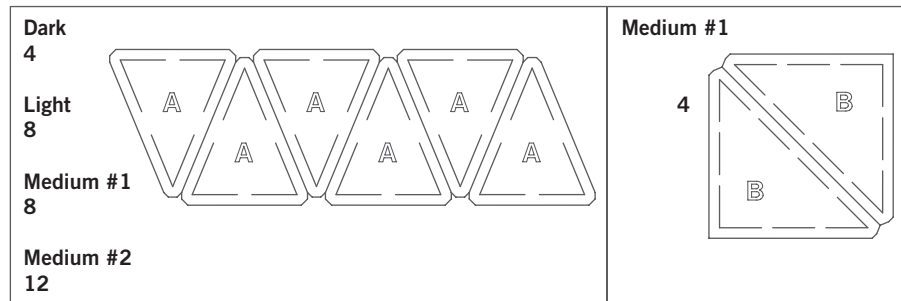

## Fabric Cutting Tips for a 4-color, 12" finished Morning Star Block:



Shapes needed for 4-Color 12" finished Morning Star Block

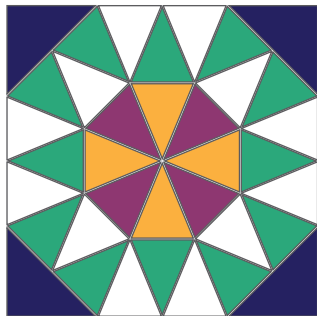


### Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

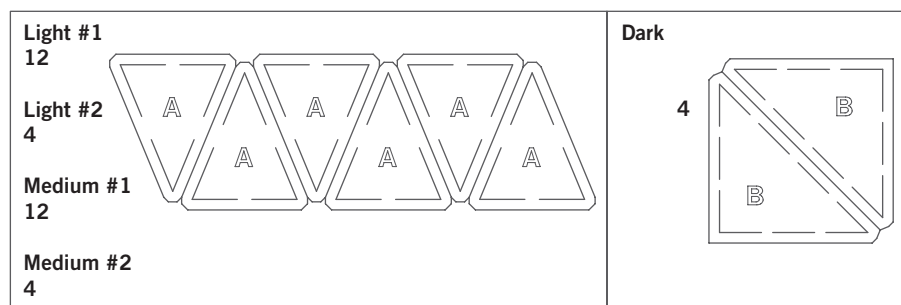
- Fabric Color 1 (dark/blue): Cut one 12" x 4½" rectangle and place over A shapes.
- Fabric Color 2 (light/white): Cut one 12" x 4½" rectangle and place over A shapes. Cut one 5¼" x 4¼" rectangle and place over two A shapes on the left side of the board.
- Fabric Color 3 (medium/light teal): Cut one 12" x 4½" rectangle and place over A shapes. Cut one 5¼" x 4¼" rectangle and place over two A shapes on the right side of the board. Cut two 4⅞" x 4⅞" square and place over B shapes.
- Fabric Color 4 (medium/dark teal): Cut two 12" x 4½" rectangles and place over A shapes.

*Note: You will have two extra isosceles triangle shapes for color #1. Set aside for future blocks.*

## Fabric Cutting Tips for a 5-color, 12" finished Morning Star Block:



Shapes needed for 5-Color 12" finished Morning Star Block



### Place fabric over shapes then run through the cutter:

- Fabric Color 1 (dark/blue): Cut two 4⅞" x 4⅞" squares and place over B shapes.
- Fabric Color 2 (light/white): Cut two 12" x 4½" rectangles and place over A shapes.
- Fabric Color 3 (light/yellow): Cut one 12" x 4½" rectangle and place over A shapes.
- Fabric Color 4 (medium/green): Cut two 12" x 4½" rectangles and place over A shapes.
- Fabric Color 5 (medium/purple): Cut one 12" x 4½" rectangle and place over A shapes.

*Note: You will have two extra isosceles triangle shapes for color #3 and #5. Set aside for future blocks.*

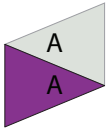

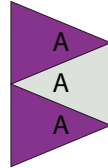
## How to Sew the Morning Star Quilt Block:

### Step 1



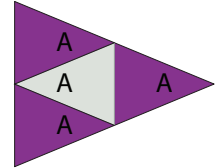
Sew two contrasting colors of A pieces together as shown to make A/A unit.

### Step 2



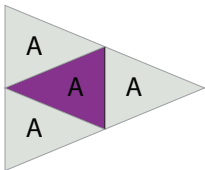
Sew a third A piece to the A/A unit as shown to make A/A/A unit.

### Step 3



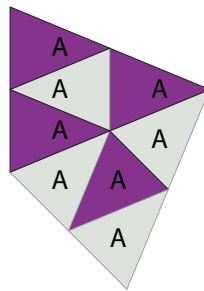
Sew a fourth A piece to A/A/A unit as shown. Make four #1-A/A/A/A units.

### Step 4



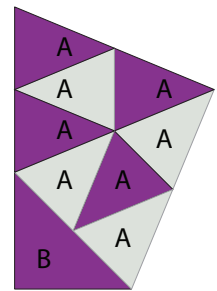
Repeat steps 1-3 using the opposite colors. Make four #2-A/A/A/A units.

### Step 5



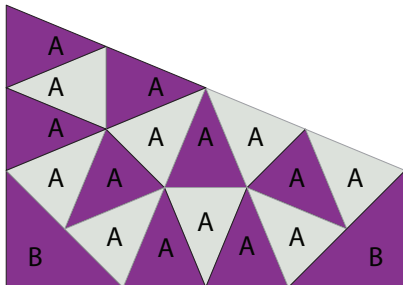
Sew #1-A/A/A/A unit to side of #2-A/A/A/A unit as shown.

### Step 6



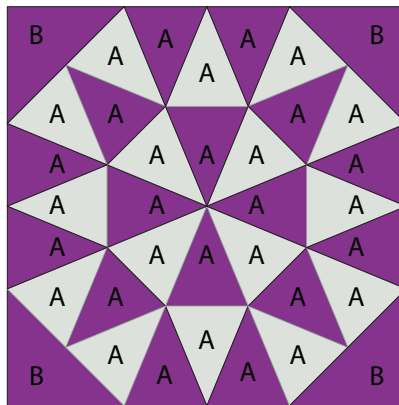
Sew B piece to corner of #2-A/A/A/A unit. Make four units.

### Step 7



Sew two quarter units together as shown to make a half block.

### Step 8



Sew two half blocks together to complete block. Block should measure 12½" x 12½".
