



Honour the Light Brigade Panel Quilt

53" x 63"

Supplied fabrics may differ from image

Materials: -

- 1 x Light Brigade Light Horse Panel
- 20cm x ½ wof Aus Imperial Force Badge
- 20cm x ½ wof Lest We Forget Rising Sun
- 20cm x ½ wof Brigade Badge
- 20cm x ½ wof Poppy Perfection Vine
- 20cm x ½ wof Remembering Stripe
- 1m Grunge Khaki
- 35cm x wof Remembering Poppies Cream
- 50cm Brown Fabric for binding



Cutting Instructions: -

- Panel
 - 1 x Cut so it measures 33 ½" x 42 ½"
- Inner Border - Grunge Khaki
 - Cut 4 strips at 2 ½" x wof
- Sashing between blocks - Grunge Khaki
 - Cut 3 strips at 2 ½" x wof
 - Subcut 16 strips at 6 ½" x 2 ½"
- Outside Border - Grunge Khaki
 - Cut 5 strips 2 ½" x wof
- From each 20cm x ½ wof strips cut 3 squares measuring 6 ½" x 6 ½" Fussy cut as needed.
- Poppies Cream cut 2 at 17 ½" x 6 ½" and 2 at 20 ½" x 6 ½"

Instructions: -

All seams are a ¼inch sewn.

1. Take the Inner border strips and sew to the edges of the panel. Side strips will measure 42 ½" x 2 ½". Top and bottom strips will measure 37 ½" x 2 ½"
2. Arrange the blocks and sashing around the panel, referring to the picture, layout blocks as desired with the poppies meeting in the top left and the bottom right corners. On the sides you will use the 20 ½" x 6 ½" poppy fabric and along the bottom you will use the 17 ½" x 6 ½". In between each block is a 6 ½ x 2 ½ sashing piece. Sew together to form the border strips being mindful of orientation.
3. Once all 4 border strips have been sewn, attach to the inner border, left and right sides first and then the top and bottom.
4. For the outside border, stitch together the 2 ½" x wof strips and cut to 59 ½ x 2 ½" for the left and right sides and 53 ½ x 2 ½" for the top and bottom. Attach the left and right sides first and then the top and bottom.
5. Quilt as desired and sew on binding in your preferred method.
